Introduction

Solugaz Propane distributes propane gas for the residential, commercial, industrial and agricultural sectors, and offers propane delivery and filling services to businesses and individuals. With 24-hour operations spread over multiple sites, some of which are difficult to access and adjacent to wooded areas, the business, which transports hazardous materials, faces a number of safety challenges.

The context

Transporting hazardous materials entails risks such as intrusion and theft, equipment damage and vandalism. The biggest challenge for Solugaz Propane's two branches in Rimouski and Saint-Augustinde-Desmaures was access control, as delivery staff circulate at all hours of the day and night. Trains arriving at night must be unloaded quickly. Mr. Mickael Gignac, Information Technology Manager, IT Specialist of Solugaz Propane, knew that to guarantee the efficiency and safety of operations, he needed a single security solution that would encompass each location, providing him with remote surveillance of both sites.

A few months prior, a Solugaz Propane site with a rail terminal in the Saguenay region suffered extensive damage as a result of vandalism. Equipment was damaged, and several 400-litre propane cylinders were knocked over as a result of numerous rifle shots. Following this incident, the company contacted GardaWorld for an emergency solution to secure the site through continuous surveillance of the installations.



The solution

GardaWorld Security Systems – Canada Major Accounts Business Development Manager, Matthew McGrory, prepared a quote for an emergency security service from Solugaz Propane. Two days later, security cameras were installed in strategic locations throughout the site, providing a 360-degree view.

For its Saint-Augustin-de-Desmaures site, located in an industrial park, the business installed security solutions such as interior and exterior security cameras, an integrated intrusion detection and access control system, and 24/7 video surveillance from GardaWorld's monitoring centre.

For logistics and transport companies, it's crucial to control access to facilities. Thanks to GardaWorld's security system solutions, designed and installed according to Solugaz Propane's unique needs, access management is streamlined and drivers only have access to specific areas.

In winter, the company faced an efficiency and logistical challenge when trucks had to enter and leave the yard at a single location due to ice. GardaWorld proposed the installation of an additional gate equipped with a scanner that could be opened remotely, giving drivers a few extra minutes to leave before the gate closed. This customized solution helped resolve the situation for Solugaz Propane throughout the winter period.

Following the installation of a GardaWorld surveillance system, the client noticed an improvement in securing their assets and facilities, and no further incidents of vandalism have been reported. Remote access management is very effective for Solugaz Propane's operations, providing managers peace of mind, cost savings and limiting travel.


